- PICU = Pediatric Intensive Care Unit
- VAC = Vacation
- EMS = Emergency Medical Services
- A = Administrative (may include duties such as performing a quality review project with the associate ED director, presenting at and attending a hospital peer review committee, specific meetings to attend with the ED director, conference attendance, and others).
- All research months have a small number of ED shifts (6 or less) and all fellows are expected to work on their research throughout the year, even if not on a research month. Fellows only have in house calls on PICU and Trauma. All other months either represent shift work only, or are call-free, unless the fellow chooses to spend extra time on call during elective or orthopedic months.
