Specialty and Urgent Care - East Valley Center

Highlights of the expansion include:

- An 11-story patient tower, the center point of the new Phoenix Children's Hospital. High-volume public spaces – like admitting, the cafeteria, and retail pharmacy – will be located on the ground floor, with upper floors devoted to our Centers of Excellence, other clinical programs, and private patient rooms. The new Hospital will also feature 96 PICU/CICU rooms and 12 more operating rooms. *(Opening 2011)*
- A traffic light and highly visible main entry boulevard off Thomas Road, leading to parking for patients, families, visitors, and medical staff, offering direct access to the new patient tower.
- An increase from 345 licensed beds today to 626 by 2012. *(In progress)*
- Adding 1,000 new jobs through the Hospital expansion project and an additional 2,000 jobs in the new Hospital.
- Negotiating a strategic alliance with St. Joseph's Hospital and Medical Center that will transfer a substantial portion of St. Joseph's pediatric service line to Phoenix Children's. This landmark collaboration will unite the hospitals' pediatric medical staff, nurses and other staff, by mid 2011. *(In progress)*
- Adding new programs like PCH Sports Medicine for Young Athletes, which focuses on injury prevention and dedicated care for growing athletes, and the Neuro-Newborn Intensive Care Unit, which offers state-of-the-art care for babies who suffer a lack of oxygen before or during birth.
- Growing existing programs like the Children's Neuroscience Institute, which provides comprehensive care for children with neurological and behavioral disorders, often with complex and interrelated conditions.
- Arizona's only Level 1 Pediatric Trauma Center where the most severely injured youngsters receive comprehensive life-saving treatment.
- A 6,018-square-foot specialty and urgent care center located at the Loop 101 and 51st Avenue, opened in 2009, providing much-needed care to patients and families in the Northwest Valley. The Hospital's Specialty and Urgent Care - East Valley Center opened in 2007.
- An innovative, energy-efficient Edwin and Nancy Van Brunt Central Energy Plant will conserve energy and water, saving the Hospital 5.6 million gallons of water and \$750,000 annually.
- A renovation of the Phoenix Children's Julie and Tim Louis Newborn Intensive Care Unit, which at 110 licensed beds is the largest and one of the most innovative facilities of its kind in the nation.
- An 18-unit Ronald McDonald House that provides a home away from home for families of seriously ill children receiving treatment at our Hospital.
- A 750-car employee-only parking garage.
