Five Phoenix Children's Outpatient Clinics Make Move to New Tower: On Monday, Jan. 31, five Phoenix Children's outpatient clinics opened for business on the second floor of the Hospital's new tower.

The Center for Pediatric Orthopaedic Surgery and the Divisions of Pediatric Dermatology, Endocrinology, Gastroenterology, and Pulmonology started offering outpatient clinical services on that day, representing the initial phase of the transition to the new main campus tower.

Pediatric Hepatologist Joins Phoenix Children's Division of Gastroenterology: Tamir Miloh, MD, a pediatric hepatologist, has joined Phoenix Children's Division of Gastroenterology, where he is charged with developing a comprehensive Hepatology and Liver Transplant Program.

The only board-certified pediatric hepatologist in the state of Arizona, Dr. Miloh is triple-board certified in pediatrics; pediatric gastroenterology, hepatology and nutrition; and pediatric transplant hepatology. An avid researcher, he has been a participating investigator in single and multicenter studies on compliance with medical regimen, liver transplantation, portal hypertension, acute liver failure, sclerosing cholangitis, and non-alcoholic fatty liver disease. He also has more than 30 publications in peer-reviewed journals and has presented at national and international meetings.
